2. Venue and Date

L'ADONITE 505 SWISS OPEN will be held from Friday October 2nd till Sunday, October 4th 2015 on the lake of Neuchâtel near d'Estavayer-le-Lac.

3. Rules

The regatta will be governed by :

- 3.1 The "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF.
- 3.2 Swiss federal law for inland navigation with local amendments will apply.
- 3.4 The 505 class rules.
- 3.5 Changes published on the black board will apply.
- 3.6 If there is a conflict between languages, the French text will take precedence.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1 The Championship is open for boats from other countries.
- 4.2 Competitors (skipper and crew) must be members of a Club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply.
- 4.3 All participants must be member of the 505 association of their country of residence.
- 4.4 Competing sailors and boats must conform to the rules of the 505 class.

5. Advertisement

- 5.1 Competitor advertising is permitted.

6. Entry

- 6.1 The original documents mentioned below must be submitted on site during entry confirmation at the registration office.
 - Copy of the Measurement Certificate or Certificate of Conformity
 - Copy of the Swiss Sailing member card of the license
 - Copy of the confirmation of the legitimacy for competitor advertising on Swiss boats.
- 6.2 Entries shall be submitted exclusively on line at the following address:

- 6.3 Deadline for entries : Entries shall be received by the Organizing Authority no later than Sunday, September 20^{est} 2015. Late entries will be accepted till Friday, October 2nd 2015 at 10am at a increased fee.
- 6.4 Fee : CHF 130.- per boat.
Fee for late entries : CHF 180.- per boat.
The fee shall be paid on site.
- 6.5 Free Beer after the races and official dinner (excluding beverages) are included with the entry fee for each competitor.

- 6.6 Spectators desiring participating at the official diner (Friday 7th September) shall be mentioned on the entry form. The cost of CHF 45.- per person shall be paid together with the entry fee or at the registration office.

- 7.2 Number of races:
-The format of racing is a single series of 9 races
-The maximum number of races per day is 5

8. Measurement

- 8.1 The Measurement Certificates are verified during the check-in at the registration office.
8.2 No first measurement will be carried out.

9. Courses

- 9.1 The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. Penalty System

- 10.1 No comment.

11. Scoring

- 11.1 Low Point System (appendix A RRS).
11.2 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores.

12. Prizes

- 12.1 The following prizes will be awarded :
- Prize money 1st CHF 4'000.-
- Prize money 2nd CHF 2'000.-
- Prize money 3rd CHF 1'000.-
- Prize money 4th CHF 600.-
- Prize money 5th CHF 400.-
- Souvenir prize for each participant
12.2 The special prizes will be given at the end of the Championship when at least one valid race has been sailed.

13. Mooring & Parking

- 13.1 During the check-in each boat will be assigned a place ashore by the harbour master.
13.3 A parking space will be available for the trailers. Trailers must be parked at the designated parking.

- 13.4 Parking spaces for cars and trailers will be made available to the competitors and accompanying persons for free for the whole duration of the Championship.
- 13.6 Parking spaces will be available at the following locations :
- Trailers: According to the instructions at the check-in on site.
 - Cars: According to the instructions at the check-in on site.
 - coach boats : According to the instructions given by the harbour master.
 - Camping busses / tents : According to the instructions at the check-in on site or at the two campings of Estavayer-le-Lac (Lacustres / Nouvelle Plage).

14. Support Boats

- 14.1 Support boats shall be registered at the registration office before the beginning of the event and comply with the Support Boat Regulation for the championship.
- 14.2 Support boats will be part of the security arrangement for the Championship.

15. Social Events

- 15.1 The following events will take place:
- Friday, October 2nd : Free Beer, aperitif at the Club House
 - Saturday, October 3rd (evening): Free Beer, then official dinner

16. Doping

- 16.1 Doping controls are possible at any time according to regulations of Anti-doping Switzerland.

17. Liability & Insurance

- 17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). By entering and participating in the Championship each competitor acknowledges that he or she waives and releases any and all claims that he or she may have against the organising authority, the classes and all persons connected with the Championship. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 17.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event (min. 2 Mio CHF) and valid for racing.
